Sub: Grant of conditional permission to the Government Ayurveda Medical College, Gurukul Kangari, Haridwar, Uttarakhand with 50 seats in BAMS (UG) course under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 for the academic session 2014-15 – reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Department's order No.R.17011/191/2013-EP (IM-1) dated 24.10.2013 related to admission matter for the year 2013-14 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for the academic session 2014-15.

- 2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 10-11.02.2014 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Department.
- 3. The recommendations and visitation report of the CCIM and <u>undertaking dated 08.07.2014</u> submitted by the college to the Department to avail relaxation in respect of equipment and <u>instruments</u> have been carefully examined in terms of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2012 read with amendment Regulations of 2013, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder and as per approval of the Hon'ble HFM on criteria for grant of conditional permission to ASU colleges for taking admissions in the UG/PG course(s) for the academic session 2014-15 vide Department's letter No.R.11011/10/2013-EP (IM-1) dated 17.06.2014 (available at Department's website <indian medicine.nic.in>) and it is found that the College is fulfilling the notified and approved criteria as follows:-
- (i) <u>Teachers:</u> For UG course: 90% eligible teachers, minimum 12 Higher Faculty (Professor/Reader) in 11 departments, at least 01 eligible teacher in each of 14 Departments and 09 Part time teachers;

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- (ii) Beds in hospital: Minimum 60 beds in Hospital of Colleges for upto 60 UG seats;
- (iii) Minimum 120 patients per day in OPD during the year 2013 for upto 60 UG seats;
- (iv) 40% bed occupancy for PG College in IPD during the year 2013;
- (v) Equipment and instruments: Minimum 50% of required equipment as specified under the schedule VII of MSR; and.
- 4. It has, therefore, been decided to grant conditional permission to the Government Ayurveda Medical College, Gurukul Kangari, Haridwar, Uttarakhand with 50 seats in BAMS (UG) course for the academic session 2014-15 under section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 subject to the condition that the college shall fulfill the following conditions by 31st December, 2014 which will be verified for granting permission from the academic session 2015-16 onwards (a copy of Assessment Sheet of CCIM is also enclosed):
 - (i) All the Minimum Standard Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2012" read with amendment Regulations of 2013 by 31st December 2014 to get permission for a period not exceeding five years. Failing which, as per Sub-regulation (4) of Regulation 3 of Regulations namely the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2012" read with amendment Regulations of 2013, "All the existing colleges, which are not able to achieve full compliance of the requirement as specified in these regulations by the 31st December, 2014, shall be denied permission from academic year 2015-16 onwards and action as envisaged under section 21 of the Act shall be initiated against all such colleges apart from rejection of their applications under sections 13A or 13C, which have been under consideration by way of conditional permissions or denials".
 - (ii) All the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.

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- 5. The fulfillment of the conditions attached to the permission given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted to the Department of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCIM also. The CCIM will verify by means of an inspection that the conditions have been fulfilled and submit a report in this matter to the Department of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the session 2015-16.
- 6. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
